Mental Rubrics

Mind maps present materia medica logically and visually. Symbols and illustrations familiar from the poems keep the specific remedy in mind as you explore the rubrics. Maps are colour-coded to reinforce repertory relationships.

The maps displayed online at www.enjoylearninghomeopathy.co.uk show Keynote or Level 3 and 4 rubrics only. In these downloadable maps the scope is wider, including Level 2 rubrics.

This booklet includes Liliium tigrinum Mentals rubrics.

Focus on one page of the map at a time until the patterns and colour-codes fix themselves into your visual memory. Begin at the core and click the links to reveal more detailed and specific symptoms. Change to a different activity or take a break for a while, and then study another section. Return to the map a day or so later and see how much you can remember.
